10:00am—1:00pm Walking Tour of Grounds for Sculpture led by Brian Carey, original and on-going landscape architect for this sculpture park. Once the site of the New Jersey State Fairgrounds, GFS is a 42-acre sculpture garden with over 270 large-scale contemporary sculpture pieces. Brian will describe the design process that transformed the site into a garden, the use of innovative building materials, maintenance, construction and plantings. (3 CEUs.)
